

Why Is the Rapture a Biblical Concept? (Matt 24:40-41)

After commenting that the last days of the Church Age are like Noah's days, Jesus mentioned a scenario of the Rapture. Some have questioned whether Jesus was referencing the Second Coming, for being "taken" could mean being killed by the sword (word) from the mouth of Christ in Glory. But the Hebrew Matthew made it clear that those being taken are the righteous, not the evil. So He must be talking about the Rapture of the Church. Biblical reason for the Pretribulational Rapture is presented.
