

Judgment for the Servants at the Second Coming

(Matt 25:31-46) Preached Sunday, June 10, 2018

Jesus gives the Parable of the Sheep and Goats to show the standard of judging the servants (nations during the Tribulation). The 144,000 Jewish evangelists are the “least of the brothers” because they are the latest ordained servants, as Paul was the least of the apostles because he was the latest ordained one. Receiving these evangelists means accepting their message. So the people from the nations are still saved by faith, not works. If one does not read the parable “dispensationally,” they easily would be led to the false doctrine of works salvation. This parable seems to fit the context of the end event of the Tribulation (the Second Coming).
